A particular position using this title may not perform all duties listed in this job announcement. Conversely, all duties performed on the job may not be listed.* Under direction operates, adjusts, and regulates sewage plant pumps, valves, and other equipment, takes periodic readings of relevant gauges, and may conduct routine standardized tests on sewage samples; does related work as required. Attendant also Takes periodic readings of relevant gauges and records these readings as well as opens and closes appropriate valves. Candidates must have the ability to utilize various types of electronic and/or manual recording and information systems used by the agency, office, or related units. Candidates must possess the knowledge of procedures used in operating, adjusting, and regulating sewage plant pumps, valves, and other equipment.
